## TPWT- 5th Site

Now providing meals in Mandaluyong

Last June 17, 2024, Tulong Para sa Walang Tahanan (TPWT) opened its fifth site in providing food to the homeless in areas close to Tahanan Ng Panginoon Joriz site, Mandaluyong City.

Our brother Alan Lim, an active member of TNP JoRiz, began providing meals to 10 homeless persons for five days in a week. This initiative was later integrated with TPWT making this, officially, their fifth site.

The other TPWT sites include Macapagal, Roxas Blvd, Sta Mesa and Diliman Quezon City.

This apparent growth brought TPWT to a more challenging mission - to prepare and distribute an average of 681 hot-meals to our homeless brethren every week in 5 different sites.

We continue to rely on God's providence. Thank God for blessing the mission of feeding the poorest of the poor.

### Addressing Education Challenges - Vital Role of NGOs

Limited funding, overcrowded classrooms, inadequate facilities, lack of teachers - these are just some of Philippine education challenges in the slum areas. Most of all, a significant lack of financial resources is a very obvious challenge to many of our Kababayans.

Non-profit Organizations play an important role in addressing these issues and help provide educational support to marginalized communities.

**The Phil Foundation of Tahanan ng Panginoon, Inc.**, continues to implement a subsidy program to help provide financial assistance to parents - to cover for transportation cost, baon, books or uniforms and internet data.

The **TEAP** (Tahanan Educational Assistance Program) is a financial assistance program to offer to TNP youth who desire to complete High school or College. This is a blessing in bridging the gap to educate the youth in the narrow alleys and bring hope and success to their quality of living and their families. This fosters community development and positive impact locally in the slums.

Thank God for all NGOs, who desire to help and support the marginalized and materially challenged brethren. Truly, God is gracious and merciful, slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love. He desires equality among men.

Our programs and activities include Evangelization, Fraternal Spiritual Growth, and Advocating Strong Family Values.

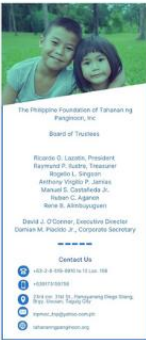
We prioritize Education and Youth Development for service to the Church and local community.
